Dear Parents/Guardians

Pupil drop off/collection arrangements

All pupils should be dropped off and collected at the 'Kiss and Drop' (off of the Hook Norton road).

There are only two exceptions to this:

<u>After prep</u> pupils are to be collected from the Junior School car park, as detailed below. (As the evenings darken, we do not want pupils walking to the Kiss and Drop.)

If a pupil needs to be collected during the school day, for example, to attend a medical appointment, they should sign out at Reception before being collected from the main entrance, and upon return, 'sign' in at Reception to ensure we have an accurate record of pupils on site.

PLEASE NOTE: This Kiss and Drop is a busy area. Please drop your child off and move away as quickly as possible.

Prep/After School Clubs

Pupils in Years 7-13 who remain for prep or an activity <u>must remain in school until 5:45pm</u>. Prep is not a drop in and out session. Pupils booked in must remain for the duration.

Parents arriving for collection should park in the Junior School Car Park, at the rear of the dining room, and collect pupils from the <u>outside</u> of the Dining Room at 5:45pm. Please do not enter the dining room.

Ordinarily, pupils in the Junior School, who have siblings in the Senior School, will be taken to the dining room to await collection by parents/guardians. However, at present, due to COVID-19 restrictions, the dining room is not open for non-boarders.

Junior School pupils should be collected from the gazebo by 5:30pm.

In an emergency

If you have an emergency and are unable to arrive at 5.45pm, your son/daughter will be with boarding pupils. Please call the duty phone to establish where they are.
